GENERAL INFORMATION

DIRECTIONS TO TDU AND VST SITES: We will meet by the bus shelter unless construction prohibits then we will meet at the parking lot above it by the Patty Center.

From the Parks Highway – Exit Geist Road, turn left at Thompson Drive, hang right in the roundabout, and then turn right into parking lot across from the Patty Gym.

From the Richardson Highway – Turn left at Airport Way, go through town to University Avenue, and turn left to Geist Road. Turn right to Thompson Drive, then turn right. Hang right in the roundabout, and then turn right into parking lot across from the Patty Gym.

From the Airport – Toward town on Airport Way to University Ave, turn left to Geist Road. Turn left to Thompson Drive, then turn right. Hang right in the roundabout, and then turn right into parking lot across from the Patty Gym.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TDX AND TD SITES: From Fairbanks take the Richardson Highway south to North Pole. About 1.5 miles past the Badger Road exit/ Giant Santa Claus on the right, take the Buzby/Dawson Road exit. At the light, turn left and take the next right onto Mistletoe Rd. and follow it to the Chena Lakes/ North Pole Flood Control Project. We will meet in the large paved parking lot immediately on the left as you enter the Project.

NO UNENTERED DOG WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE TRACKING TEST AREA

ALL DOGS WILL BE KEPT ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES OR RISK BEING MARKED FAILED WHETHER THE DOG HAS RUN OR NOT

BITCHES IN SEASON may participate in accordance with AKC rules (Chap 2, Sec 8). The Tracking Test Secretary and Judges must be notified before drawing for tracks. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for these bitches will be held. Bitches in season will go on the last track(s) laid and owners must take care as to not foul any area where other dogs may be.

BY THEIR PRESENCE on the tracking test grounds, all exhibitors and spectators agree to abide by AKC rules and Regulations and to follow the instructions of the Tracking Committee to the best of their ability. Chapter 1, Sec 22 of AKC Obedience Regulations states, "...the owner or agent entering a dog in an Obedience Trial (or Tracking Test) does so at her/his own risk...". TVKC, the Tracking Test Secretary, the Tracking Test Committee and the landowners of the tracking test site assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury to any dog or person on the tracking test site; or loss, damage or injury to any dog or person traveling to or from such site.

FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ENTRIES. No entry fees will be refunded if the test cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of TVKC.

DRAWING AND TEST WORKERS OPTION If more entries than the test limits are received, a drawing will be held to determine which entries will participate in the test. The drawing will be random, except that preference will be given to those dogs which have not previously earned a title in the entered test. The drawing will consist of two parts. The first draw will be for test workers as defined by the hosting club, from previous tests in accordance with the following table. The second draw will be for all remaining entries. When the limits have been drawn from all entries, all remaining entries shall be assigned to a position on the alternate list corresponding to the order in which they were drawn. The drawing will be held on Sun, Aug 6th, 2017 at the Tracking Cabin at 1538 2nd Ave, Fairbanks, AK 99701 at 8:15 PM. All persons submitting entries are invited to attend.

AS VST AND TDU ARE COMBINED TESTS, AKC's exchange policy will be in effect. If the limit for entries in one test (VST or TDU) is not reached, and the limit for entries is exceeded in another test (VST or TDU), a number of tracks may be exchanged, not to exceed the limits set in AKC Tracking Rules and Regulations Chapter 1, General Regulations, Section 19

AWARDS will be presented to dogs passing all tests, provided by the TVKC Tracking Fund.

MAKE ALL CHECKS PAYABLE TO TVKC and mail fees and entries to Lee Wood 1524 2nd Ave Fairbanks, AK 99701. To drop off an entry, call (907)590-6150 to make arrangements. No telephone entries will be accepted. All entries must be received no later than 8:00 PM Sunday, August 6, 2017, after which time entries cannot be accepted or changed.

A RECORDING FEE of \$.50 and an Event Service fee of \$1.50 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club tracking test. This recording fee is to be collected by the show giving club and paid to AKC (Chapter 11, Sec 2).

VARIABLE SURFACE TRACKING TEST

Limited to three (3) dogs and alternates

Combined test with TDU

Entry Fee is \$115.00

This test shall be for dogs that have earned the TD or TDU title and are otherwise eligible under AKC regulations.

All dogs scheduled to run VST and TDU Test tracks must be at the tracking area by 6:00 PM Friday, August 18th, 2017 at which time there will first be a drawing for the running order of each dog TDU dog, followed by a drawing for the running order of each VST dog. The first TDU track will be run shortly after these draws, at judge's discretion, followed by VST. In the event of any absentees among the confirmed entries, the next alternate, in catalog order, who is present, will be allowed to fill the vacancy.

THIS VST TEST is limited to 3 dogs which have received a Tracking Dog title. If more than 3 entries are received, a drawing will be held to determine which entries will participate in the test. The drawing will be random, except that preference will be given to those dogs which have not previously earned a VST title. The drawing will be held on Sun., Aug 6th, 2017 the Tracking Cabin at 1538 2nd Ave, Fairbanks, AK 99701 at 8:15 PM. All persons submitting entries are invited to attend.

WHEN THREE entries have been drawn, an alternate list shall be drawn subject to the same preferences set forth in the preceding paragraph.

THE ALTERNATES will be advised of their position on the alternate list and given an opportunity to be at the test site in case of absent dogs. Alternate entry fees will be refunded unless the alternate actually participates in the tracking test. Entry fees will also be refunded to any confirmed entry that does not participate in the test, provided that the Test Secretary is notified prior to the day of the test and provided that an alternate entry participates in the test as a result of the withdrawal.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Variety: If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering. I.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog. I.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
