CLASSES OFFERED

Outdoors two rings, Rings will alternate so no rings run at the same time, starting each day with Ring 1. Preferred classes will run with the corresponding regular classes and height divisions. Master and Excellent classes will run together.

First Received–Entries accepted in order of receipt: “Paper and Online Limits” The “initial limits” are valid for the first 48 hours after the opening date. 50% of the entries will be accepted via paper entries. 50% of the entries will be accepted via on-line or email entries.

- Illegible, incomplete or incorrect entries will not be accepted.

- Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side will not be accepted.

- Judging Schedule and confirmation will be sent to the email address on the entry form. If the Judging Schedule has not been received by five days prior to the trial, please contact the trial secretary at TVKCagilitysec@gmail.com.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

There will NOT be height measurements at this trial as this judging is a NOT VMO.

It is no longer required that a copy of a dog's jump height card be submitted with an entry form or show it at check-in; although exhibitors are required to have the official form/card with them at the trial to present upon request.

MOVE UPS

For move-ups prior to trial, the trial secretary must receive request by **5:00 p.m., Monday, August 23, 2021**. The following information must be provided: Owner's name, dog's registered name and call name, AKC registration number, breed, class currently entered, and new class requested. Move-ups will be official only when confirmation is received by the requesting party.

For day to day move-ups, trial secretary must receive completed form by 30 minutes after close of judging on Friday & Saturday. Blank forms will be available from the trial secretary at the trial.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

Stickers for ribbons will be available for self-serve ribbon distribution. Ribbons will be awarded to dogs placing first through fourth place in each height division of each class. Ribbons will be awarded to each dog that receives a qualifying score.

Ribbons will be offered to any dog completing a new title.

Ribbons or pin will be offered to any dog completing a Double Q Score.

Ribbon or Rosette will be offered to any dog completing the MX or MXJ title.

Rosette will be offered to any dog completing the MACH, PACH, or PAX title.

If you may be able to achieve any of these 3 titles at this trial, please let the trial secretary know to alert the awards chairman to bring ribbons/bars.

High In Trial and runner-up JWW and High In Trial and runner-up JWW(P) will be chosen from the JWW & JWW(P) dog that has the best yards per

second qualifying score. Prize will be \$25 for each winner and \$10 for the runner-up for Friday and Saturday. Prize will be awarded at the briefing the next morning.

AGILITY GATE APP CHECK IN, RUN ORDERS AND MAPS

You will check in via the **Agility Gate App**. Instructions and pass code are sent out with the final entry confirmations. If you need to move a dog WITHIN YOUR JUMP HEIGHT, click "conflict" and can fix it at the gate BEFORE your walk thru. The scribe can reorder those sheets for the moves during the walk through. The Gate Steward is the **ONLY** person to move dogs after the run order after they are posted on the Agility Gate App. All moves must be within AKC rules and with permission of the judge. If you need to 1) move to a different jump height; or move to a different class; or have multiple dogs you are running in same class and need more separation, contact the trial secretary. The TV displaying the current run order and dogs in queue will be displayed near the ring entries. The Gate Steward will be at a table near the rings and please respect the space around the steward's station.

Preliminary class results will be posted near the trial secretary trailer or in a binder book. Full results will be emailed after the trial.

There will not be printed maps for pick up. Maps will be emailed to exhibitors the night before and posted in the Agility Gate app. A copy of the maps will be displayed near the judge's table. If you don't have access to email or the Agility Gate App at the trial, let the trial secretary know via email before the trial.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

We would like this event to be a pleasant experience for all in attendance.

We ask your cooperation, please, in the following areas:

This trial will be held under AKC rules and regulations for agility trials.

Exhibitors are expected to be familiar with these rules and regulations.

Participants who leave dogs, equipment and personal belongings unattended, do so at their own risk. The show giving club(s) and the owner(s) of the site will not be responsible for dogs, equipment or personal belongings, nor for the loss of, damage to, or death of any dog, whether the result of accident or any other cause.

All dogs must be kept on leash, in crates or in vehicles at all times except when competing.

Participants will be responsible for clean conditions (**including picking up after the dogs in their care**) around crates, tents and parking spaces.

Dogs must be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged or in any way has anything

attached to it for medical purposes. Bitches in season shall not be eligible to participate. There will be a **100%** refund of entry fees due to bitches in season.

There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date, other than for bitches in season. If the dog/handler are dismissed from the competition, regardless of the reason, there will be no refund.

Dogs must be ready to compete. The judge need not wait for any dog that is not ready to compete when its number is called by the gate steward. The judge will take a half-hour lunch break at a convenient time.

Participants shall be governed by any rules and regulations of civil authorities and/or location restrictions. Please obey all posted signs.

Parents or guardians must be responsible for children. Children must be kept under supervision of an adult at all times.

Vehicles will be allowed to park in designated areas only. Vehicles parked in undesignated areas will be towed at the owner's expense.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A collection fee will be added to the amount of each returned check.

Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the judge or veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.

All rights to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit these events are vested in the Club or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club. All persons & animals on the show grounds at any time while the shows are in progress do, by attending these shows or participating therein, hereby grant to the Club the right to photograph, televise, videotape or otherwise use their likeness & voice in any manner without further release or consent.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

A complete set of rules, current full class descriptions and eligibility are available on the AKC website (www.akc.org) or by requesting Regulations for Agility Trials from the American Kennel Club, 5580 Centerview Drive, Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606.

The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower or higher height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

Entering a mixture of Regular and Preferred classes:

Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. If a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Dogs may be entered in any height division they are eligible for but may only enter each class offered once per day. If a dog is entered in different jump heights the owner must submit separate entry forms, one for each height. When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out.

The following jump height divisions shall be used in all trial Regular classes:

8 Inches: For dogs 11 inches and under at the withers.

12 inches: For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers.

16 Inches: For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers.

20 Inches: For dogs 22 inches and under at the withers.

24 Inches: For dogs over 22 inches at the withers

24 Inch Choice: Dogs may be entered at this height at their owner's discretion if their measurement is 22 inches and under at the withers.

Entering "For Exhibition Only" (FEO)

If still allowed by AKC at the time of entries, FEO will be offered in the Time 2 Beat. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out.
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and/or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time – Time is course time – not max course time.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

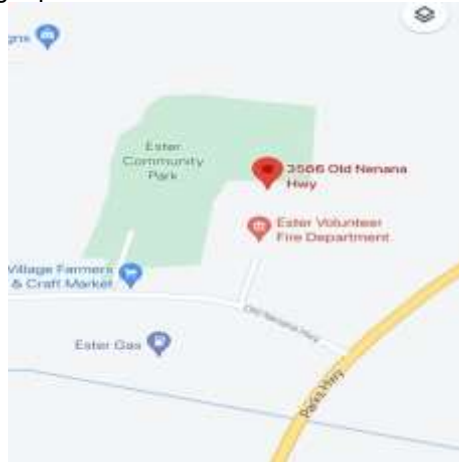
If still in effect by AKC, Fix and Go On will be for all classes. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to

successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
