Please join us for the final snif-n-go run through before our April trial!

PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS WILL BE AN OUDOOR EVENT. Let's enjoy that lovely sunshine as we focus on working outdoors – Exteriors and Containers.

A snif-n-go is a fun run for dogs and handlers to practice their scent work. To participate you must be a member of the Tanana Valley Kennel Club with an event waiver on file and current rabies vaccination certificate. You can join the club online via Event Payments, and the Event Waiver is available at the TVKC website homepage <https://tanavalleykennelclub.com/> Please plan to bring a picture or copy of your dog's current rabies vaccination certificate.

Registration: \$20 per dog. You may pre-register online at www.tanavalleykennelclub.com using the event calendar or pay cash/check during check-in.

Check-in Time: April 5th between 5:30pm and 7:00pm. *No check-ins prior to 5:30pm.*

Please leave your dog(s) in the car while you check-in and wait to be called.

If you have multiple dogs, please be sure to mention it to the volunteer handling check-ins. We'll do our best to accommodate you with spacing between other teams.

Preferably your dog(s) will have had some scent work training at the Novice level or higher. There will be a time limit of 3-5 minutes per search. Anyone interested in this fun new sport is encouraged to come watch!

Search areas will be designed for all levels, Nov – Master using birch, anise, clove & cypress. Depending on weather, plan to be outside for one or more of the searches.
