Recipe of the Month

Want some different ideas for bait for those hungry hounds? Check here each month to keep them interested in what you have to offer! Chicken Chips (for Fido)

2 cooked (boiled) chicken breasts
1 clove garlic
1/2 cup chicken broth
1 cup whole wheat flour
1/2 cup cornmeal

Puree chicken and garlic in a food <u>processor</u> or blender. Add in chicken broth. Transfer mixture to bowl and stir in remaining ingredients until it's not sticky anymore. Cut dough in half and shape each into a 1 1/2-inch diameter roll. Wrap in <u>plastic wrap</u> and chill thoroughly.

Slice into thin <u>chips</u>. Bake chips on lightly greased <u>baking sheet</u> at 350 degrees F for 25-40 minutes, turning halfway through <u>baking</u> time. Chips will harden as they cool.
